The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Mindel at 7:10 P.M.

The Commissioner thanked the members for attending on such short notice and informed everyone that the purpose of the meeting was to set the meeting dates and agendas for the rest of the year and to discuss the remediation and monitoring of the 1111 Marcus Avenue site. Copies of information on the NYSDEC proposed remediation action plan were distributed to the members and a discussion ensued. Commissioner Mindel informed the members that if the Environmental Commission determines that there are any issues that were not being addressed by the proposed plan that might affect the Village the Commission would advise the Board of Trustees. The Commission will come up with a list of items that they want confirmation on as being tested for as well as get a better understanding of where the sentinel wells will be installed.

Commissioner Mindel outlined 5 topics that the Commission will undertake or revisit over the course of the 4 scheduled meetings for 2014/2015 as follows:

- 1-Electronic Waste Recycling Day
- 2- Monitor the results of testing at 1111 Marcus Avenue
- 3- Revisit the proposed leaf blower law
- 4- Revisit the golf course's chemical use
- 5-Revisit the proposed banning of the use of coal tar for paving

On a motion by Commissioner Mindel, seconded by Vincent Lentini the Commission moved into Executive Session at 8:40 P.M. to discuss litigation issues. Commissioner Mindel reconvened the regular meeting at 8:50 P.M. and since no action had been taken during Executive Session, there are no minutes.
