Commissioner Hoffman called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

On motion of Carl Mittler, seconded by Sue Goldman, the minutes of September 3, 2014 were unanimously approved.

Bob Johnston reported that the course has been aerated and fertilized for the fall. The underbrush has been cleaned up on the 9th tee and now there is a clear view of the water. Fall tree pruning has begun. Fall projects have begun and include work on the 8th tee; re-irrigating and the surrounds.

Robby Mistretta reported the golf course show case was on the 29th of September and 18 people attended. There weren't enough participants to warrant opening the restaurant so instead there was no charge for the day and lunch was ordered and served in the SAC room. A few more people were unable to attend but will play later this month. Two new members already joined as a result of the mailing that went out earlier.

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Commissioner Hoffman will send a letter to the membership concerning the height of the rough and in that letter he will remind everyone of the "Refer a Friend Rewards Program".

Archie Abrams reported that basically we are on budget for Year to Date.

The commission members discussed the 2015 non-resident dues, on motion of Archie Abrams, seconded by Sue Goldman it was unanimously voted not to increase any non-resident dues.

The members discussed maybe making an offer to weekday members to step up to a full membership. The proposal is a discounted senior membership for a period of two years. In addition a list of all available categories (up grading) will be included in this year's mailing to existing members for the 2015 season.

The commission members reviewed and approved the 2015 calendar. Changes to the calendar will be made as necessary.

The valet service will continue until October 26, 2014.

The commission members reviewed a credit request from Sea Soon Park due to illness which only allowed him to play two times this season. After discussion, it was unanimously agreed to credit Mr. Park 100% towards his 2015 membership dues.

Commissioner Hoffman proposed charging a \$28.00 fee whether you walk or ride. There was a discussion but no decisions were made.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 pm.
