The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Milner at 7:35 P.M.

**APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES- May 5, 2014**

Kara Mindel motioned to accept the Minutes of May 5, 2014 as presented, seconded by Dina Burachio and unanimously approved by all those present.

**MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES**

Commissioner Milner reported that the Board of Trustees approved the appointment of Lorraine Shakter as an alternate member.

**HANDBALL WALL**

Commissioner Milner informed the members that Elliot Browar evaluated the condition of the wall and gave his recommendations on how to repair it. After discussing it further with DPW, the Commissioner suggested the best course of action at this time will be to scrape and paint the wall and fix the immediate concerns so that it is usable for this season. The DPW superintendant will provide a letter to the camp as to what the plan is to repair the wall and when it will be scheduled to be done so that the camp has it on hand for their Nassau County Department of Health inspection. Once the season is over DPW will take off all the layers to determine a final remedy and fix the wall before next season.

**DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

The director reported that the opening weekends went well. The staff will continue to plan activities as attendance increases.

**LABOR DAY BBQ**

Planning of the Labor Day barbeque will be discussed at the next meeting.

**SOCIAL EVENT**

The members discussed having on a wine and cheese event on a Friday in early August. Dina Burachio will contact the concessionaire to see if he has interest in catering the event being Culinart already has a full schedule and it is becoming difficult to coordinate a date with them.

### **OTHER ISSUES**

Dina Burachio reported that she has a list of 7 members interested in an early evening water aerobics class. Commissioner Milner will contact an instructor to see if classes can be arranged.

A discussion ensued regarding improving the look of the pool gardens. Dina Burachio and Kara Mindel will contact a local landscaper, Raul Carballo, to add plantings at a cost within the Park's planting budget.

### **PERMISSION TO USE THE FIELD**

Commissioner Milner motioned to allow Lakeville Elementary School to use the Village ball field for a picnic on Friday, June 13 from 11:30 am to 2:30 pm, seconded by Dina Burachio and unanimously approved.

### **PRESENTATION AT MOVIE NIGHT**

The Commission discussed whether to include a presentation spearheaded by the Environmental Commission on avoiding toxins in the home prior to the start of the movie. The consensus was that movie night was not the best venue with all the activity on the field before the movie begins and the members were concerned about the lack of attention that would be paid to the guest speaker. Commissioner Milner will inform the Environmental Commission.

### **RENAMING SOFTBALL FIELD**

The members did not show an interest in renaming the field at this time. The request was made by Vincent Lentini and as he was not in attendance they will ask for the impetus of his request at the next meeting.

### **PICKLE BALL**

Lorraine Shakter passed around information about the details of the game. The game is played with a whiffle type ball, ping-pong type paddles and is played on a court the size of a badminton court. A discussion ensued on the best location to set it up. Lorraine will contact a company to invite them to come to the park to demonstrate the game, preferably on a weekend. They can look at the facility and give their advice on the best area for the set up. She did not anticipate any fee being charged for this.

### **CHAIRS**

The Commission discussed adding more sit up chairs to the pool's furniture inventory. Dina Burachio will research some options to consider.
