APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES- June 30, 2014

Jonathan Witt motioned to accept the Minutes of June 30, 2014 as presented, seconded by Sharon Perlson and unanimously approved by all those present.

COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

Commissioner Milner reported that a timer has been installed on the chlorine pump to shut it off overnight and turn it on in the morning in order to better regulate the system. The new sit up chairs have been delivered. The old plastic chairs will be put out by the tennis courts and the playground. The replacement of the cushions of the old terrace chairs will be postponed until there is a better indication that the members are using the chairs.

The Commissioner gave permission to the Soccer League to use the field for a soccer clinic from August 25-August 29.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The director reported that the staffing will be adequate through the end of the summer. The camp director, Maria Rudman, indicated that there might be a few camp counselors of high school age that might be interested in a lifeguard position for the end of the season. Pool activities are planned for the Labor Day barbeque.

WATER AEROBICS

Dina Burachio reported that the classes are going well averaging 11 attendees and servicing about 20 residents. Due to all the pool activities planned and the heavy use of the pool during the barbeque it does not seem feasible to hold the last Sunday class on that day. Dina will see if the instructor can reschedule the last class. Commissioner Milner asked Dina to get a feel from the residents if there is an interest to expand the program for next year. Resident Ellen Gottlieb was in attendance to let the Commission know that she is very appreciative to the Village for providing the classes and to commend the instructor for her efforts.

LABOR DAY BBQ (Sunday, August 31)

Vincent Lentini will head the barbeque committee. Set up will begin at 10 AM with the food being served beginning at 1:30 PM.

MOVIE NIGHT #2

The event is scheduled for Sunday, August 31 at 8 PM. Robert Gal will email a list of non-animated movies to the Commission members to vote on. Commissioner Milner asked Rob to research the cost of purchasing a movie system.

POOL TEMPERATURE

The director will inform DPW to decrease the pool temperature a few degrees due to complaints of the water being too warm.

BASKETBALL COURT

Commissioner Milner will ask Trustee Handsman to look into the cost of installing another basketball court.
