Commissioner Kaplan called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

On motion of Bill Zimmerman, seconded by Larry Baily, the minutes of March 6, 2019 were unanimously approved.

Deputy Commissioner Milner gave a brief budget report. Mr. Milner reported that it does appear that we are slightly down but we are still awaiting the auditor's final report. It is too soon to determine exact totals.

The Village Open House was a huge success. The Golf table had many new residents inquire about the course and membership. Robby Mistretta has already received some follow-up telephone calls from interested residents.

The commission members reviewed the current membership. Year to year comparison is slightly lower but it is expected that members will come to play with payment in hand. Robby Mistretta will make sure they fill out and sign new applications that he will have available in the Pro Shop.

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Robby Mistretta gave an update of the USGA rules review evening. It was attended by approximately 60 people and it went well.

Commissioner Kaplan discussed the new changes to the Tour GCX program. It is expected to bring anywhere from 250 to 300 extra rounds. In the past it has run smoothly and is still expected to do so, the only difference being in how the payments are to be handled, now that they are owned by Century Partners/Arnold Palmer Management. We will now charge \$100 per player.

The course rest room renovations are completed. Commissioner Kaplan and the board were very impressed with the results and complemented Mr. Alex Ma of Fortis Construction and his team on their work.

Jonathan Price gave the golf course report. Mr. Price discussed current and preventative ongoing course maintenance. Mr. Price said that his crew has been working hard cleaning up all the debris left from the tree renovation project. Stumps were ground by hand, holes are currently being filled. Although rain is predicted for opening day the course will be ready.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 pm.
