Deputy Commissioner Kaplan called the meeting to order at 8:00 pm and welcomed Jin Song. Mr. Song attended this meeting because he may be interested in becoming a golf commission member.

On motion of Sue Goldman, seconded by Bill Zimmerman, the minutes of March 9, 2016 were unanimously approved.

Bob Johnston reported on the condition of the golf course. The sink hole has been repaired and the pipes have been reconnected. The course has been fertilized and planting sod will begin this week. The cart path on the 9<sup>th</sup> hole will be removed and several others will be repaired. Several dead trees have been removed and the areas cleaned up. All of the bunkers will be edged and cleaned up. There have been complaints that the greens are slow during the week therefore the greens will be rolled more often during the week. The projected golf course opening date is March 25<sup>th</sup> weather permitting.

Most non-resident members have returned for the season along with 19 new members and 2 new corporate memberships. Residents are beginning to register and several have upgraded their membership categories.

Discussion continued on the resident membership promotion day. Brad Rudman reported that the date is May 15<sup>th</sup> with a rain date of May 23<sup>rd</sup>. Mr. Rudman distributed copies of the draft invitation. The invitation will be mailed and emailed to all residents. In an effort to reach all residents this invitation will be sent in English, Korean, and Chinese.

Carl Mittler (via email) reported the contract with Classic Valet Services has been renewed without an hourly increase. The rate remains \$13.75 per man hour and valet service will begin Friday April 29<sup>th</sup> and run until October 23<sup>rd</sup>. There will be two attendants, consisting of Pepito and a new runner. Coverage will be from 7am to 7pm on Tuesday Thursday & Friday, Wednesday 7am-9pm Saturday and Sunday 6am-9pm. These times are adjustable as needed.

Deputy Commissioner Kaplan began a discussion on Corporate Membership. The Golf Commission recommended 10 members but the Board of Trustees voted and passed a limit of 8 members. Due to a miscommunication, the existing Corp. Memberships have 10 members. This issue will be brought to the attention of the Board of Trustees and revisited by the commission before the 2017 season. Gym privileges are not available to corporate members.

A request was made by Larry Baily for a refund of dues for his daughter, Ariel due to a sports injury. Ariel played 9 holes twice this year. The Commission members suggested a full refund less the cart fee for two rounds. On motion of Adam Hoffman, seconded by Meri Berger a motion to credit Mr. Baily \$620.00 was unanimously approved.

Robby Mistretta reported that so far he has two spotters and two rangers for the season.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45pm.
