Commissioner Hoffman called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

On motion of Bill Zimmerman, seconded by Meri Berger, the minutes of June 3, 2015 were unanimously approved.

Bob Johnston gave an update on the golf course. Pengat is coming in September to repair the broken irrigation pipe which has caused a sink hole on the course. The work should take about five days. We are awaiting a firm commitment to the date and the cost.

Archie Abrams gave a budget report for the year ending May 31, 2015. We had budgeted for a deficit of \$192,000.00 which depletes the surplus we had in the beginning of the year. Subject to adjustments the actual deficit reflects \$337,000.00.

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This creates a deficit of \$145,000.00. The deficit is mostly a result of a decline in membership.

Commissioner Hoffman said he had spoken with a group that was interested in corporate membership but they wanted to play one foursome on the weekend. The commission members all agreed one foursome on the weekend could be added to the corporate membership for an additional fee.

The commission members began a discussion on bringing in new members. Many clubs offer a six month membership and some of the new members that joined here came for the remaining six months. This may be an option for new members.

In an effort to maintain new members, beginning next year they will have a day to play with a commission member as an introduction to the course and it's members.

The commission discussed a request from Irene King for compensation of 2015 golf dues. Ms. King paid in full but didn't play due to injury. The commission members agreed to offer Ms. King a full credit towards 2016.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm.
