The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Milner at 7:35 P.M.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES- June 1, 2015

Kara Mindel motioned to accept the minutes of June 1, 2015 as presented, seconded by Suzanne Browar and unanimously approved.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Amanda reported that the weather has interfered with many of the recreation activities but new activities will continued to be planned. A July calendar will be posted. Four new lifeguards are in the process of being hired and will join the staff in the next couple of weeks. These additions will bring the number of lifeguards to 17 which is the same as last season.

MOVIE NIGHT

Commissioner Milner reported that the Village will never use the movie company that handled the June movie night again due to the poor service they provided. The Village Administrator has asked the company to refund the fee paid to them. The members discussed that although the showing had its technical difficulties, the evening was still appreciated by the residents who enjoyed the evening out on the field with family and friends. The Commissioner reminded the members that the Trustees have not rescinded the approval of the purchase of a movie system but they have suggested continuing to rent for this season to gauge the popularity and attendance of additional event dates before making the commitment to purchase. The Village will go back to using Funflicks for the movie events. A discussion ensued on the movie choices. Upgrading electric service to the field was discussed.

Commissioner Milner motioned to approve the proposal from Funflicks to provide the remaining 4 scheduled movie nights of the 2015 season (July 9, August 6, September 4 and October 30) at a cost not to exceed \$3,000 subject to adjustment in cost for any extra time required for the October event, seconded by Robert Gal and unanimously approved.

LABOR DAY BBQ

Vincent Lentini reported that Trustee Mindel will be able to order the food needed for the barbeque at a wholesale price. A discussion ensued on the barbeque entertainment. In addition to the popular dunk tank other suggestions included face painting, balloon twisting, a speed pitch or pop-a-shot game and three-legged and potato sack races. Final decisions will be made at the August meeting.

OTHER ITEMS

The discussion of possibly renaming the ball field will be brought up at a future meeting. Vincent Lentini suggested adding another basketball court next to the current one. A discussion ensued. Commissioner Milner will discuss with DPW what will be involved.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 pm.
