The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Farkas at 7:30 pm.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES- February 27, 2019

Jonathan Witt motioned to accept the minutes of February 27, 2019 as presented, seconded by Dina Burachio and unanimously approved.

MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

Commissioner Farkas reported that the Board of Trustees approved the 2019 park fees.

COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

Commissioner Farkas informed the members that approval of the proposals for the grout and tile repair of the main and kiddie pool by Tortorella, the up-grade of the tennis court irrigation by County Irrigation and the 2019 movie night series by Funflicks was done at the Board of Trustees level at their April meeting.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Denise Hernandez updated the Commission on staffing. There are 12 returning lifeguards with 2 additional pending certification. There are 7 gate guard of which 3 have CPR certification. Commissioner Farkas informed the members that the directors suggested that this season the tennis courts should kept locked and a gate guard will open upon request once park membership has been verified and applicable fees collected. Additional gate guards will be hired because the prior season decision to keep the roster at a minimum and not man the tennis courts was not successful. The Commission was in agreement.

The directors will follow up with one of the lifeguards to see if he has an interest in taking over the Social Media responsibilities.

VENDING MACHINES

Nationwide Vending can provide the pool with one machine each for beverage, snack and ice-cream. The Commission was provided with a list of products available. A discussion ensued about the best location to place the machines whether inside the existing snack shop or outside.

Commissioner Farkas will discuss further details with the owner.

Dina Burachio will reach out to the concessionaire at Christopher Morley Park to see if there is interest in running the snack shop.

WATER AEROBICS

Assia Winfield is willing to come back this season. Naomi Strauss, one of the trainers from the Village's fitness center, is also interested. A discussion ensued about possibly adding more classes before the pool opens full time.

POOL GARDENS

Dina Burachio reported that the new price list from the nursery comes out in another couple of weeks. She anticipates keeping her budget around \$2,300. She also suggested purchasing some Leyland cypress trees from Lowe's to add in front of the back fence by the badminton court and to ask DPW to divide the hostas along the path in front of pool entrance to fill in space.

REQUEST FOR PARK MEMBERSHIP

Naum Landaverde, a Village employee, asked for limited park membership for himself and his family for 2019. A discussion ensued. Michael Cohen motioned to allow limited park membership for Naum Landaverde, his wife and 2 children, seconded by Jonathan Witt and unanimously approved. The membership will carry no guest privileges.

JUNE MOVIE NIGHT

A discussion ensued about whether the field would be in usable condition. The Park Commission secretary informed the Commission that the House Committee Chairman, Trustee David Milner, approved the reservation of the ballroom from Culinart for Village use for June 21. The Park Commission was very appreciative. Deputy Gal will contact Funflicks to discuss indoor screen options for use in the ballroom.

Deputy Gal will send the Commission an email of movie choices to decide on.

Commissioner Farkas floated the idea of getting a food truck to include the pool to their route for an hour on Saturday and Sunday. He asked the Commission members to reach out to food truck companies in the area.

The Park walk around is scheduled for Monday, May 6 at 7pm with the meeting to be held immediately following in the Camp room.

The need to purchase additional chairs will be evaluated after the current inventory is removed from storage.

On a motion by Commissioner Farkas and seconded by Suzanne Browar the meeting was adjourned at 9:10 pm.
