**COMMISSIONER'S REPORT**

Commissioner Farkas informed the Commission of the landscaping work that was done at the park. Before and after pictures were circulated. Additional discussion on further landscaping ideas will take place during the winter meetings.

There has been ongoing discussion at the Trustee level on whether to reconfigure the ball field. A landscaper that specializes in park design visited the field and will submit a proposal with ideas to consider.

Kara Mindel motioned to approve the 2020 Park Commission meeting dates as presented, seconded by Sharon Perlson and unanimously approved.

**2019 POOL REVENUE/LABOR DAY BBQ EXPENSES**

The Commission reviewed the schedules provided. Commissioner Farkas reported that although park membership did not increase, pool revenue did increase which is attributed to an increase in helper passes, guest card sales and guest fee revenue. The increase in the barbeque expenses is due to the increase in the cost of the ice cream by purchasing from the concessionaire.
