Dear Residents:

Spring finally has emerged from the winter and soon it will be time to enjoy our Village's park and pool. Our pool will open for the season on May 26, 2018 and will remain open for the weekend after Labor Day, September 8 and September 9.

Our fellow residents, who are members of your Park Commission, have been hard at work to make the park and pool a truly magnificent facility. We have continued to keep this year's fees extraordinarily low. **Membership fees for 2018 will be \$55 per person age 4 years and older, with cap of \$220 per family.** Residents will still be permitted to purchase daily admissions, though for anyone considering using the pool or tennis courts more than once or twice during the season, we ask that you consider purchasing a seasonal membership. Only seasonal members will be permitted to bring guests provided the applicable fees are paid¹. **IN NO EVENT MAY A GUEST OR RESIDENT PAYING A DAILY ADMISSION FEE BRING A GUEST.**

Denise Hernandez will be returning as our Park Director. We will continue to strive to give each resident the personal service they deserve as a member of our community; greeting you by name and offering more personal assistance. We have also planned many events and activities designed to bring our family and community closer together. Assisting Denise in this endeavor will once again be Jilian Weihs. Please join me in welcoming back Denise and Jilian.

Our park, pool, tennis courts and ball fields are intended for the exclusive use of our residents and their guests. We require that all residents who plan on using these facilities obtain a Leisure Pass ID card at the Village Office. The recreational staff has been instructed to only allow those with valid ID cards and their guests to use our facilities. Your ID card must be displayed when entering the pool or requesting a tennis court. Those using the ball fields and basketball court must display their ID card if requested by a Village employee.

The Village happily permits children, grandchildren, parents and grandparents of seasonal members whose name you have listed on your application (i.e.: "family members") to have access to our pool facility on weekdays without requiring that a member accompany them. Family members are required to pay the applicable guest fee. While we will continue to offer this privilege, in order to protect against abuses that have occurred, "family

¹ If you will be bringing guests, consider purchasing a prepaid guest pass. Prepaid passes are available to paid members of the pool and offer a generous discount and do not expire. Guest passes are available for purchase from the Village Office or at our pool.

members” will be required to provide picture ID confirming their identity before being permitted access. We ask that you make your family members aware of this policy.

Each year we look forward to our residents’ celebrations at the pool. For those of you planning an event at the pool, we ask that you coordinate with the Director. Doing so will insure that your guests and the others who will be using the pool on your special day will all be able to enjoy the facility.

Tennis/Badminton: This season our tennis players will continue to enjoy playing on three different surfaces; hard, Har-Tru or red clay. Our Tennis Committee, and our Tennis Professional, Xavier Cedeno, has prepared an exciting schedule of events for our tennis players. The schedule has been included in this mailing.

In addition to our wonderful tennis courts, we will be adding a badminton court for everyone’s enjoyment.

Snack Bar: The snack bar will again be operated by Consolidated Food Services, Inc. Dmitri and his team will do his best to accommodate our needs.

Special Events. The Park Commission’s Special Events Committee has planned some great events this season. As has become tradition, we have scheduled 4 “Movie Nights.” The first will held on Friday, June 15th. Lynn is coming back with her energetic water aerobics classes starting June 24th. Our now famous Labor Day Barbeque will be Sunday, September 2nd. We also have our annual Family Fun Night planned for August 3 and Floaty Days are scheduled throughout the season. New this year will be a Planting Day where kids and parents can help plant our garden. This is just a small sample of our events. There are activities planned for almost every day. Also, although not a Park sponsored event, please mark your calendars for the second annual Village Block Party on the field on July 28. There will be live music and a variety of food trucks.

Until becoming Commissioner, I didn’t appreciate all the work that our Park Commission members, Joe Barone from DPW and our Park Commission secretary, Dianne Morrissey, put in to our parks. I am personally indebted to all of them for their hard work. Furthermore, your Village’s Park Commission, year after year, has volunteered countless hours to ensure a great summer for all their neighbors. I have been very privileged to work with them over the past year and a half. They all deserve our gratitude for putting together what we hope will be our best season ever at Lake Success.

At the beginning of this summer my term as a Village trustee will expire. The job of Park Commissioner will go to Larry Farkas. Larry has been a great Deputy Commissioner for me and I’m sure will continue our Park’s success.

Its Village facilities like our pool and park that create the extraordinary value of our neighborhood. We pour a great deal of our tax dollars into maintaining these facilities.
