2020 RULES AND REGULATIONS - POOL

PLEASE READ ALL RULES CAREFULLY, AS THE RULES HAVE BEEN SIGNIFICANTLY MODIFIED BECAUSE OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC. ALL RULES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE AS THE SUMMER PROGRESSES, IN ORDER TO ACCOMMODATE RESIDENTS AND/OR TO MAINTAIN SAFETY OF THE POOL OR THE PARK FACILITY.

Residents must comply with **ALL RULES** stated herein or as may be modified during the course of the pool season, or posted at the facilities. Residents should familiarize themselves with these rules.

Eligibility: Admission to and use of the pool, tennis and park facilities is limited to enrolled Village residents. **No guests shall be permitted**, except for caretakers/mothers helpers/aides.

Enrollment: To become a member you must meet residency requirements. Please refer to the Village website for a copy of the application and for dates and times for pre-registration. Applications and payments may also be brought to the pool on the first day that you come to use the pool. All persons seeking membership must provide satisfactory proof of Village residency at the time of submission of the application.

Admission: **ADMISSION WILL BE BY RESERVATION ONLY**

INITIAL DAYS AND HOURS OF OPERATION:

THE POOL WILL OPEN ON FRIDAY JULY 10, 2020.

THE POOL WILL BE OPEN UP TO SEVEN DAYS PER WEEK. HOWEVER, BECAUSE OF POOL STAFFING, THE POOL MAY NOT BE OPEN EVERY DAY. WE ENCOURAGE RESIDENTS TO CONTACT THE POOL GATE FOR DAILY UPDATES.

THERE WILL BE 2 DAILY POOL SESSIONS:

MORNING SESSION: 10:30 A.M. – 1:30 P.M.

AFTERNOON SESSION: 2:30 P.M. – 6:00 P.M.

NOTE: Members must leave promptly at the end of their session. In between sessions, the facilities will be closed so they can be cleaned as may be needed.

Note: Days and Hours of operation are subject to adjustment based upon safety, weather conditions and staffing.

RESERVATIONS REQUIRED:

Reservations must be made in advance by calling the pool gate at 516-306-4411 between 12 Noon and 4:00 pm the day before. A confirmation email will be sent to the email listed on the membership application. Reservations are not final without confirmation by email by the pool staff.

THERE WILL BE NO WALK INS ALLOWED. NO EXCEPTIONS.

LIMITATION ON POOL ATTENDANCE:

In order to ensure proper safety, attendance at the pool will be limited.

The number of persons allowed in the pools will be limited.

MEMBERSHIP FEE FOR RESIDENTS:

Seasonal resident membership fees for each individual age 4 and over is **\$55 per person not to exceed \$220.00 per family (excluding children age 25 or older).**

REFUNDS: No membership refunds will be issued.

NO RESIDENT DAILY ADMISSION PRIVILEGES -

All members who want to use the pool and tennis facilities must obtain a membership. There will be no daily admissions permitted at this time.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: Application procedure and application forms are posted online. Applications may be completed and submitted at the park on July 6th and July 7th from 10 am-6 pm. Applications may also be completed and submitted on the **first day** you come to the pool.

LOCKER FACILITIES: There will be no locker facilities at this time.

VILLAGE PARK, POOL AND TENNIS RULES: The park and tennis rules have been previously posted. Please visit the Village website at www.villageoflakesuccess.com/parks_rec.php for a copy of the rules.

The Recreation Directors are in charge of the pool and all recreation areas. The Directors are responsible for rule enforcement and are authorized to deny use of the facilities to anyone violating the rules. The Director reports any violations which warrant further action to the Park Commissioner. The Commissioner is empowered to enforce these rules by suspension of privileges or other appropriate means.

FOOD: There will be no food concession this season. Members will be permitted to bring in food provided they clean up after themselves.

We encourage members to bring sufficient water as our water machine will not be operational.

The following rules have been adopted by the Park Commission and approved by the Board of Trustees. Failure to comply may result in a hearing before the Grievance Committee of the Park Commission.

VILLAGE POOL

HYGIENE: THE NASSAU COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT REQUIRES ALL PERSONS TO SHOWER BEFORE ENTERING THE POOL. THE SHOWER FACILITIES WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE THIS SEASON BECAUSE OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC. ALL PEOPLE USING THE POOL SHOULD SHOWER BEFORE THEY COME TO THE POOL.

CHILDREN REQUIRING DIAPERS MUST WEAR SWIM APPROPRIATE DIAPERS WHEN IN THE MAIN POOL OR THE KIDDIE POOL. NO PUBLIC URINATION OR DEFECATION EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED BATHROOMS.

SAFETY:

COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS:

- 1. PARK IN THE UPPER PARKING LOT OR ON LINKS DRIVE. DO NOT PARK IN THE LOWER PARKING LOT.**
- 2. ALL MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A MASK FROM THEIR CAR TO THEIR POOL LOCATION AND RETURNING TO THEIR CARS. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 3. ALWAYS MAINTAIN A SOCIAL DISTANCE OF AT LEAST SIX FEET FROM OTHER PERSONS. THIS INCLUDES PLACEMENT OF LOUNGE CHAIRS.**
- 4. MASKS ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES WHERE SAFE SOCIAL DISTANCING IS NOT POSSIBLE.**
- 5. ALWAYS RESPECT OTHER PEOPLES SOCIAL DISTANCING SENSITIVITIES.**
- 6. ALWAYS ADHERE TO THE DIRECTIONAL SIGNS POSTED AT THE POOL.**
- 7. A MAXIMUM OF THREE PERSONS SHALL BE PERMITTED IN THE LOCKER ROOM/BATHROOM AREAS AT ANY TIME. MASKS ARE REQUIRED IN THE BATHROOMS AT ALL TIMES.**
- 8. THERE WILL BE HAND SANITIZER DISPENSERS PLACED AROUND THE POOL AREA AND ALL MEMBERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO SANITIZE FREQUENTLY.**
- 9. THERE WILL BE A SEPARATE GATE FOR ENTRY AND FOR EXITING THE POOL TO AVOID UNNECESSARY CONGESTION.**
- 10. MEMBERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO FOLLOW THE ONE WAY DIRECTIONAL ARROWS AROUND THE POOL AND SOCIAL DISTANCING MARKERS THROUGHOUT THE POOL AND PARK AREA.**
- 11. PARENTS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENSURING THAT CHILDREN MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCE PROTOCOLS.**
- 12. THE POOL DIRECTORS WILL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO REQUIRE ANYONE WHO DOES NOT ENGAGE IN SAFE PRACTICES TO LEAVE THE POOL. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

GENERAL RULES:

- ❖ Supervision is provided by the Recreation Director, lifeguards and gate guards who have been instructed to enforce the Rules and Regulations.
- ❖ Within the Pool and Park areas, children under the age of 15 years must at all times be under the direct supervision of a parent or adult at least 18 years old.
- ❖ Only flotation devices approved by Nassau County and by the pool staff are allowed in the large pool and only with adult supervision.
- ❖ No glass containers of any kind are permitted within the locker building and/or the pool area.
- ❖ The concrete apron surrounding the pool must be kept clear at all times. NO SHOES, clothing, toys, athletic equipment, chairs or any other items are allowed in this area.
- ❖ Balls of any type may not be thrown in the pool or pool vicinity. No toys allowed in the main pool.
- ❖ Diving is only permitted in designated areas of the pool, and subject to the discretion of the pool staff.
- ❖ The following are prohibited in the pool area: roller blades, scooters, running, jumping or rough housing.
- ❖ NO SMOKING IN THE POOL OR PARK FACILITY
- ❖ No pets permitted in the pool or park facility.
