

Lake Success Summer Camp

The Lake Success Summer Nursery Camp (LSSC, LSC) is a resident-founded non-profit camp dedicated to the children and grandchildren of the Village of Lake Success between the ages of 3 to 9 years old.

- We provide an engaging environment for our campers to partake in new experiences, build friendships and be kids in a safe and nurturing environment! Many of our counselors were children that previously attended this camp and they are invested in making sure it's a phenomenal experience for all.
- We have the amazing village resources as our playground that includes fields, pool, tennis courts, and golf course and our camp room safely situated above the Lake Success Police Department.
- Your children will be surrounded by their neighbors and classmates! Many of the younger children find it a boost when they start Parkville and Lakeville with all their friends from camp.

What does your camper need to bring?

Each camper will need the following in a labeled container to be kept in the locker room. Please label everything with your camper's name and bring to the first day of camp.

- Sun block
- Extra bathing suit and extra towel
- Extra pair of underwear, socks, pair of shorts, and shirt
- Long-sleeve shirt or light jacket

Each day, your child should come to camp with a bathing suit on and their play clothes over the suit, sneakers on, sun block applied, and their backpack. Each day your child's backpack should be filled with 2 towels, a 2nd dry bathing suit, a pair of underwear, water shoes, and goggles as needed.

Please do not send your camper with anything peanuts or anything with nuts. Our camp facility is a peanut free zone.

What is the typical schedule?

Our typical schedules always include an array of activities alternating between high impact and low impact activities appropriate for each age group.

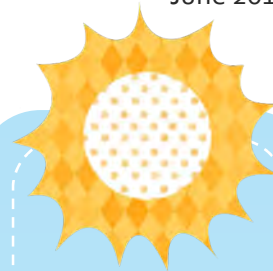
- Swimming is typically scheduled twice a day, weather permitting, with a Water Safety Instructor (WSI).
- Various sporting activities (ie, soccer, tennis, other field sports, gymnastics, bowling, golf) are generally dispersed daily through the week.
- Field trips are typically on Tues and Thurs mornings for 7yo, 8yo, and 9yo, Tues mornings for 6yo, and a selected trip for 5yo (see page 4 for details).
- Variety of entertainment and vendors come in daily (see page 3 for some our vendors but not inclusive of all that is scheduled).
- Various age appropriate Arts and Crafts projects.

What is the lunch being served?

Pizza on Friday and snacks provided in the morning and afternoon are included for all campers. Campers are welcome to bring in snacks and lunch if needed. As our camp facility is peanut free, please do not send in anything with peanuts or nuts.

Lunch on Mon. through Thurs. has been arranged with Consolidated Food Services for \$220 for each camper for the whole summer. Below is menu is subject to change. Every lunch is served with water and/or juice and yogurt.

- Mon: Chicken fingers with fries and a vegetable side
- Tues: Make your own sandwich (ham, turkey, cheese, lettuce, tomatoes, bagel/bread)
- Wed: Grilled chicken salad (romaine, tomatoes, cucumbers) with side of white rice and teriyaki and/or BBQ sauce and seaweed
- Thurs: Chicken fingers with fries and a vegetable side
- Fri: Pizza for all campers (provided by the camp)

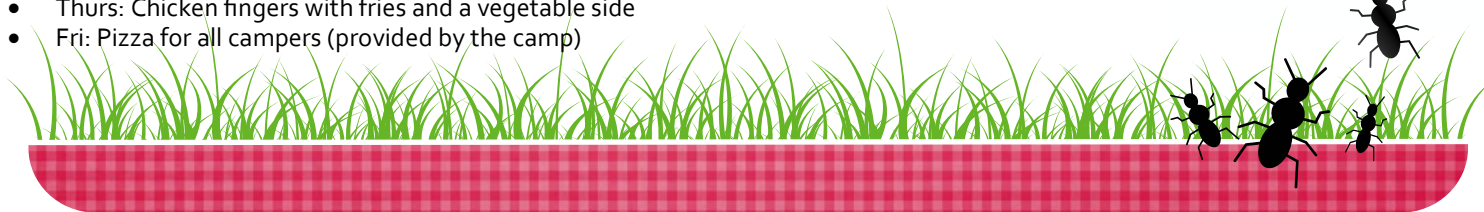

Age Group vs Grade?

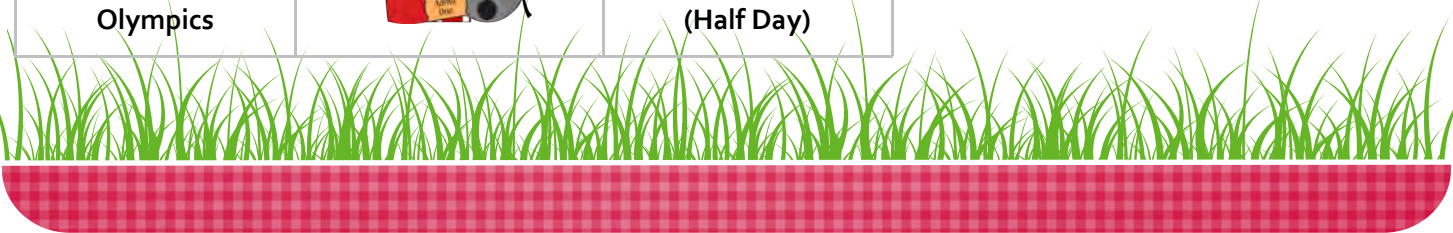
Regardless of date of birth, your child is placed in the age group by the grade he/she will be entering in Sept 2018.
