This will be the 18th summer that our camp director, Maria Rudman, MS, MBA, CPA, has been running the Lake Success Summer Camp. Maria has been a resident of Lake Success for 26 years and has raised her 3 children here. Outside of camp, Maria is a 4th grade teacher with the NYDOE for the last 15 years and previously was a pre-school teacher at the Great Neck Community School for 9 years. Important Info & Dates!

- Camp in session from Thursday, June 27, 2019 to Tuesday, August 13, 2019.
⇒ No camp on Thurs, July 4.
- **Key Dates:**
 - ⇒ 7/23, Tues—Paint & Pizza Late Night 5:30pm to 8pm (7/8/9/10yo)
 - ⇒ 7/26, Fri.—Visiting AM for parents and grandparents (Schedule to be announced). Also, picture day in the PM!
- 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, & 10 yo attend camp from 9 AM to 4 PM whereas 3 yo attend from 9 AM to 1 PM.
⇒ Extended hours for 3 yo and early care are available.
⇒ All campers must be toilet trained.

Typical Schedule at Camp

Our typical schedules always include an array of activities alternating between high impact and low impact activities appropriate for each age group.

- Swimming is typically scheduled twice a day, weather permitting, with a Water Safety Instructor (WSI).
- Various sporting activities (ie, soccer, tennis, other field sports, beach volleyball, bowling, golf) are generally dispersed daily through the week.
- Field trips are typically on Tues. and Thurs. mornings for 8, 9, and 10 yo, Wed. and Thurs. mornings for 7yo, Wed. morning for 6 yo, and selected trip for 5yo (see page 4 for details).
- Various age appropriate Arts and Crafts projects.
- Variety of entertainment and vendors come in daily (see page 3 for some our vendors on Fantastic Friday but not inclusive of all that is scheduled on the other days).

What to bring to camp

Each camper will need the following in a shoe-box sized labeled container to be kept in the locker room. Please label everything with your camper's name and bring to the first day of camp.

- Sun block
- Extra bathing suit and extra towel. Suggest a thin towel to fit in the container.
- Extra pair of underwear, socks, pair of shorts, and shirt

Each day, your child should come to camp with a bathing suit on and their play clothes over the suit, sneakers on, sun block fully applied, and their backpack. Camp staff will re-apply sun block during the day.

Each day your child's backpack should be filled with 2 towels, a 2nd dry bathing suit, a pair of underwear, water shoes, and goggles as needed.

Please do not send your camper with anything peanuts or anything with nuts. Our camp facility is a peanut free zone.




