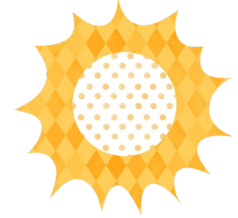


Lake Success Summer Camp



A Local Village Camp...

The Lake Success Summer Nursery Camp (LSSC, LSC) is a resident-founded non-profit camp dedicated to the children and grandchildren of the Village of Lake Success between the ages of 3 to 11 years old (entering pre-school to 6th grade in Sept 2024).

- We provide an engaging environment for our campers to partake in new experiences, build friendships and let kids be kids in a safe and nurturing environment! Many of our counselors were children that previously attended this camp and they are invested in making sure it's a phenomenal experience for all.
- We have the amazing village resources as our playground that includes fields, pool, tennis courts, and golf course. Also, our camp room is safely situated above the Lake Success Police Department.
- Your children will be surrounded by their neighbors and classmates! Many of the younger children find it a comfort when they start Parkville and Lakeville when they are surrounded by their friends from camp.

This will be the 23rd summer that our camp director, Maria Rudman, MS, MBA, CPA, has been running the Lake Success Summer Camp. Maria has been a resident of Lake Success for 29 years and has raised her 3 children here. Outside of camp, Maria is a 4th grade teacher with the NYDOE for the last 20 years and previously was a pre-school teacher at the Great Neck Community School for 9 years. In the little free time she has, she loves bicycling and traveling with her husband.

The camp is further supported by our Camp Doctor, Amy Lai, MD as well as the Camp Board consisting of neighborhood moms, Mary Chung, Myra Tran, and Ellen Yi.

Typical Schedule at Camp

Our camp is a very structured camp and always includes an array of activities alternating between high impact and low impact activities appropriate for each age group.

- Swimming is scheduled at least once a day, weather permitting. Some days it may be twice a day. Instruction is given by a Water Safety Instructor (WSI) from UrSwim and lifeguards at the Lake Success Pool.
- Various sporting activities (ie, instructional tennis with certified tennis pro, soccer with certified soccer coach, golf at Lake Success Golf course with golf professional, instructional volleyball and basketball, and other field sports depending on age) are generally dispersed daily through the week.
- Field trips are scheduled once to twice a week varying for groups 6yo and up.
- Variety of entertainment and vendors come in daily (see page 3 for some of our vendors but not inclusive of all that is scheduled).
- Various age appropriate arts and crafts projects.

What to Bring to Camp

Each camper will need the following in a **labeled gallon ziplock or extra large ziplock** bag to be kept in the chubby/locker room. Please label everything with your camper's name and bring it in by the first day of camp.

- Extra sun block
- Extra bathing suit
- Extra pair of underwear, socks, pair of shorts, and shirt. For those in the 4/5 yo groups, we recommend 2 extra pairs of underwear/socks/shorts/shirts.

Each day, your child should come to camp with a bathing suit on and their play clothes over the suit, sneakers on, sun block applied, and their backpack.

Each day your child's backpack should be filled with 2 towels, 2nd bathing suit, a pair of underwear, water shoes, and goggles as needed. Most days children will swim twice (ie, 1 instructional swim, 1 recreational swim).



Note about Golf for 7/8/9/10/11yo

* Our golf pro requires that all golfers wear a collared shirt during the golf lessons on our village golf course.

If your child shows up to camp without a collared shirt on their scheduled GOLF day, they will sit out from the lesson.

Golf gloves are optional if you feel your child may need it.

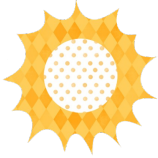
Don't worry we send reminders every day with the photo of the day emails!

Age Group vs Grade?

Regardless of date of birth, your child is placed in the age group by the grade he/she will be entering in Sept 2024.

- 4 yo group: Entering Pre-K
- 5 yo group: Entering kindergarten
- 6 yo group: Entering 1st grade
- 7 yo group: Entering 2nd grade
- 8 yo group: Entering 3rd grade
- 9 yo group: Entering 4th grade
- 10 yo group: Entering 5th grade
- 11 yo group: Entering 6th grade

Note: This is not an all inclusive list of activities and vendors. There are a number of vendors that come in weekly all summer that are not listed in this calendar. Calendar, themes, activities, and shows are all subject to change.



Tips for a Successful Summer

- Prior to drop off you need to fully apply sunscreen on your kids.... and lets not forget the top of their heads. Please use the pasty type of sunscreen as long action as possible (ie, highest SPF) in the morning to give your child a nice base coat. Sprays can be used to reapply as needed.
- Please try not to be late. Camp activities start promptly at 8AM. Sometimes coming late is hard for kids to join in when everyone is already playing.
- Everyday ask your child what their favorite activity was at camp! We send photos of the day emails every day so you can have a glimpse of our jammed packed camp day!

Please do not send your camper with anything with peanuts or tree nuts. Our camp facility is a Nut/Peanut free zone.

Hot Lunch Program

Peanut/nut free snacks as well as water are included daily. On Fridays, LSC will provide pizza from Centre Pizza (in Little Neck) for all our little campers!

This summer we will primarily be using Centre Pizza and some other local restaurants in the area to cater the hot lunch from Mon through Thurs that is charged separately. The cost for the hot lunch Mon to Thurs is \$210 per camper for the whole summer. Below is the menu we will start this summer with but depending on popularity it is subject to change. If you are interested in the hot lunch program for the summer, please make a check payable to **Lake Success Summer Nursery Camp, Inc. for \$210** and bring it during orientation or by the first day of camp. - **Mon:** Chicken tenders with fries
- **Tues:** Pasta themed menu
 - ◊ (ie, pasta, marinara/butter sauce, meatballs, cheese, baked ziti, etc.)
- **Wed:** Alternating between sandwiches (due to timing of field trips) or Mexican themed menu
 - ◊ (ie, Ham & cheese, turkey & cheese, cheese quesadillas, salsa, guacamole, tortilla chips, etc.)
- **Thurs:** Asian themed menu
 - ◊ (ie, grilled chicken, sauteed broccoli, white rice, teriyaki sauce, seaweed, etc.)
- **Fri:** Pizza for all campers (provided by the camp through Centre Pizza)

NOTE: For the 1st week of camp only, we will be planning for the following.

- Thurs 6/27 Chicken tenders with fries and on Fri 6/28 Pizza

Starting on 7/1 Mon the menu above as listed for Mon to Fri will be followed but always subject to change.

Our primary concern is keeping up with their energy throughout the day. In the morning, there is a daily dry snacks (ie, pretzels, crackers, etc) and in the afternoon snack is usually ice pop, frozen yogurt, or fresh fruit.

Children who do not like their lunch are welcome to have bagel, cereals, cheese sticks, or yogurt.

Campers may bring in their own lunch and snacks that we can refrigerate. We are unable to microwave any lunches.

As our camp is Nut/Peanut free facility, please be not sent anything with peanuts or tree nuts or exposed to any nuts.

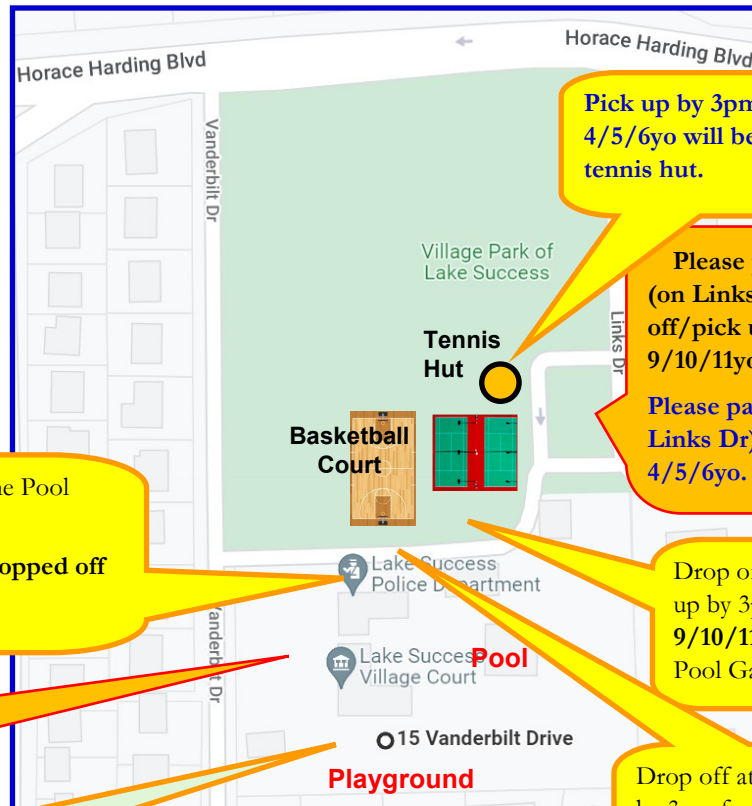
COVID-19 Precautions

Isolation and quarantine rules are in effect as dictated by NYS at <https://coronavirus.health.ny.gov/isolation-quarantine>. If your camper has a positive COVID test they must isolate at home for 5 days. If your camper has been in close contact to someone who is positive (ie, household member), quarantine is based on vaccination status similar to how schools have been handling COVID.

Drop Off and Pick Up

- To minimize and control traffic we ask you to park in the Links Dr Parking lot or the Vanderbilt Dr Parking Lot depending on camper age group (SEE ORANGE BUBBLES IN THE MAP).
- Please refer to the map at the different locations for drop off/pick up by camp group (SEE YELLOW BUBBLES IN THE MAP).
- If you have multiple children, please pick a parking lot!



Drop off at 8am for 5yo and 6yo at the Pool Gate entrance.

This is also where 4yo should be dropped off at 9am .

Please park in this lot (15 Vanderbilt Dr) for drop off for 4yo, 5yo, and 6yo.

Drop off at 8am/Pick up by 3pm for 9/10/11yo across from Pool Gate.

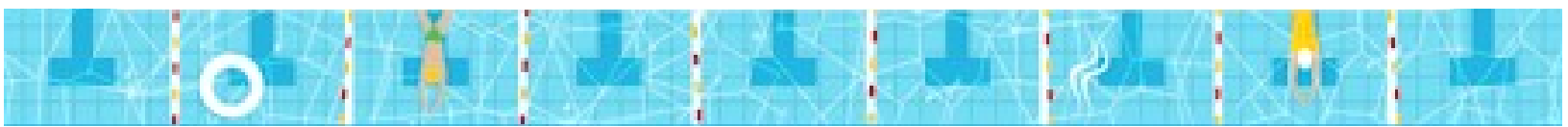

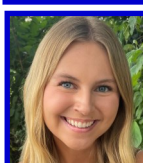

Caitlyn W. is will be a senior at GN SHS next year. She is currently involved in 8 school clubs and has been a part of her school's tennis team since freshman year.



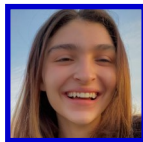

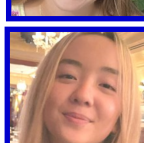
Jenna R. is a rising senior at Oneonta. She is an Early Education major and loves working with kids. This her 3rd summer at LSC and is excited for another great summer!

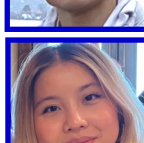
Kylie S. is a rising junior at Hofstra Univ, studying Psychology. This is her first year as a counselor but she was a camper at LSC for many years!

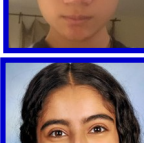

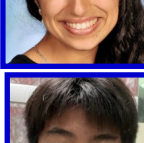
