

# VILLAGE OF LAKE SUCCESS 2023 PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

Residents and their guests must comply with **ALL RULES** stated herein or posted at the Park Facilities. Residents should familiarize themselves with these rules. The VLS Park Commission may amend the rules during the season, as required, for the safe and proper operation of the park facility.

**Membership:** Use of the park, pool and tennis facilities is limited to enrolled members, their helper/aides and guests. Please refer to the Village website [http://www.villageoflakesuccess.com/parks\\_rec.php](http://www.villageoflakesuccess.com/parks_rec.php) for a copy of the application. All persons applying for membership must provide satisfactory proof of Village residency to the Village Office at the time of submission of the application. **Completed applications and payment can be mailed to or submitted to the Village office Monday-Friday. Applications and payment may also be completed and submitted on the first day you come to the pool.**

**PARK MEMBERSHIP FEE FOR RESIDENTS:** Unless a resident non-member pays a daily admission fee as provide below, a seasonal membership will be required in order to use the pool complex and/or to play tennis.

## SEASONAL RESIDENT MEMBERSHIP age 4 and older

INDIVIDUAL	\$165
FAMILIES OF THREE OR MORE	\$ 500

**Children age 25 and older must pay for an individual membership  
and are not considered part of a family of three or more.**

**HELPER/AIDE:** Seasonal pool fee \$125. A helper/aide must be accompanied by the child or disabled member.

**REFUNDS:** No annual membership refunds will be issued after June 30.

**NO CASH TRANSACTIONS:** All payments must be by check or by a credit card paid either online ([www.villageoflakesuccess.com/xpresspay.php](http://www.villageoflakesuccess.com/xpresspay.php)) or processed with the SQUARE app at the pool. There is a processing fee for the credit card transactions. If you pay for membership using Xpresspay online please bring the Xpresspay receipt to show proof of payment at the pool gate if you join the first day of your visit.

**OR PRE-PAID DISCOUNT GUEST PUNCH CARD: \$100 (20 punches valued at \$5 per punch)**

**GUEST CARD POLICY:** A pre-paid discount guest punch card may be purchased by ONLY SEASONAL MEMBERS FOR USE BY THEIR NON-RESIDENT GUESTS, for a fee of \$100 which is valid for 20 weekday visits (\$5/guest) or 10 weekend/holiday visits (\$10/guest). All guests **MUST** be accompanied by a seasonal member, except as noted.

**GUESTS - GUESTS MAY NOT BRING OTHER GUESTS.**

Upon payment of prescribed fees, guests of seasonal members are permitted the use of the pool and tennis facilities only if accompanied by a member of the resident host family. All adult seasonal members are permitted to bring guests subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Park & Recreation Commission. Only six guests per household will be permitted on a Saturday, Sunday, or Holiday. If you plan on bringing a large group of guests to the pool on weekdays, this must be approved by the Recreation Director at least one week in advance. **Residents paying daily admission may not bring guests.**

**FAMILY GUESTS - GUESTS MAY NOT BRING OTHER GUESTS.**

Non-Resident adult children, grandchildren, grandparents, and parents of residents whose name appears on the resident's park application shall be classified as Family Guests. Upon payment of prescribed fees and **PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION at the pool gate**, family guests are permitted to use the pool and park facilities. On weekends and holidays Family Guests **MUST** be accompanied by a member of the resident host family. Please remember to complete the family guest side of the enclosed application.

**VILLAGE PARK, POOL AND TENNIS RULES**

---

The Recreation Directors are in charge of the park, pool and all recreation areas and are authorized to deny use of the facilities to anyone violating the rules or eject those not engaging in safe practices. The Directors report any violations which warrant further action to the Park Commissioner. The Park Commissioner is empowered to enforce these rules by suspension of privileges or other appropriate means.

**The following rules have been adopted by the Park Commission and approved by the Board of Trustees.**

All residents are subject to all COVID-19 policies and restrictions that may be issued by the Village of Lake Success, the County of Nassau and/or The State of New York. **The Village of Lake Success reserves the right to mandate Park members to submit appropriately dated proof of full vaccination (including booster shots, if required). If enacted, this would apply to Park guests as well.**

Further rules relating to COVID-19 restrictions are annexed hereto as Exhibit "A".

**VILLAGE POOL**

**PHONE NUMBER – Front Gate: 516-482-4764**

**ADMISSION:** A validated electronic VLS Leisure Pass Access card is needed for admission to pool by residents age 8 and over who use the **park, pool or tennis facilities** seasonally. The gate attendant will refuse access to any person who does not present their validated access card.

**LEISURE PASS ACCESS CARDS:** Electronic access cards are obtained and validated for current year membership at the Village Office. Once an access card is issued there is a replacement fee if a new card must be issued during the current or subsequent years of membership.

**REPLACEMENT CARD FEE:** \$25

**POOL OPERATING SCHEDULE:**

**Hours are subject to adjustment based upon safety, weather conditions, staffing and current Nassau County Department of Health guidelines.**

**FOOD:** Members will be permitted to bring food provided they clean up after themselves. We encourage members to bring their own reusable cups for water machine use. Cups will not be provided.

**SWIM INSTRUCTION:** Arrangements must be made with the Recreation Director for swim instruction. All instructors are Nassau County Certified lifeguards. The fee for each 1/2 hour lesson is \$20.00. Please consult bulletin board for additional information regarding instruction and other water activities.

**HYGIENE:** The Nassau County Health Department requires all persons to shower before entering the pool. Children requiring diapers must wear swim appropriate diapers when in the main pool or the kiddie pool. No public urination or defecation except in designated bathrooms.

**GENERAL RULES:**

- ❖ Supervision is provided by the Recreation Director, lifeguards and gate guards who have been instructed to enforce the Rules and Regulations.
- ❖ Within the Pool and Park areas, children under the age of 15 years must at all times be under the direct supervision of a parent or adult at least 18 years old.
- ❖ Only flotation devices approved by Nassau County and by the pool staff are allowed in the large pool and only with adult supervision.
- ❖ No glass containers of any kind are permitted in the pool area.
- ❖ The concrete apron surrounding the pool must be kept clear at all times. NO SHOES, clothing, toys, athletic equipment, chairs or any other items are allowed in this area.
- ❖ Balls of any type may not be thrown in the pool or pool vicinity. No toys are allowed in the main pool.
- ❖ Diving is only permitted in designated areas of the pool, and subject to the discretion of the pool staff.
- ❖ The following are prohibited in the pool area: roller blades, scooters, running, jumping or rough housing.
- ❖ NO SMOKING IN THE POOL OR PARK FACILITY
- ❖ No pets permitted in the pool or park facility.

## VILLAGE PARK

- ❖ The use of the Village Park, Playground, Ball Field & Track is restricted to residents and their guests when accompanied by a resident. Registration with the Recreation Director when the pool is open or with the Dispatcher in the police station at other times is required for daily use of the ball field.
- ❖ **Residents must provide proof of residency when requested.**
- ❖ The Village Park, Playground, Ball Field and Track, unless otherwise specified, will be open from 8:00 AM until dusk. The track will be closed during scheduled softball games, during selected village activities and when there is over-flow parking on the field.
- ❖ Organized teams and leagues must file an application for approval of use with the Park Commission. 51% resident membership is required for host teams, except recognized youth Leagues who have Park Commission approval to use the facility.
- ❖ Barbecuing and hitting golf balls on the Ball Field is prohibited. Football, basketball, soccer, cricket or softball may be played in areas designated for that purpose.
- ❖ Bicycle riding is prohibited on the ball field and track. Bicycles, when not in use, must be placed in the racks provided.
- ❖ Only appropriate athletic footwear is to be worn when using the track. No cleated shoes.
- ❖ **Dogs, cats or other pets are not permitted within the park boundaries.**

**Bathrooms** are available at the ground floor entrance of the police station.

**TRAFFIC:** No motor vehicle, including motorcycles, motor scooters and mopeds shall be permitted to park, stop or stand at any place in any area of the Village Green except in the designated parking areas. Maximum permitted speed is 5 MPH. Vehicles must be parked on paved areas at all times.

## TENNIS AND PICKLEBALL COURTS

A paid park membership fee and application is required for residents to play on the tennis and pickleball courts. There shall be no more than 4 players on a court at any given time. If there are players rotating into a game, they must wait outside the gate of the tennis court. Resident members must bring proper photo identification to be displayed upon request by the Attendant.

**Tennis/ Pickleball Guests:** A limit of 3 guests is allowed per court. Guest fees are \$10 per guest payable at the pool gate. Guest fees must be paid by **prepaid guest punch card only**. The guest punch card can be purchased at the pool gate or Village office.

The tennis courts will only be open during the times that the Village has personnel available to manage and supervise the courts. We will endeavor to have the courts open from 7am to dusk every day, but that is subject to change.

**SUPERVISION:** The Tennis Pro and Assistant Pro and park/tennis attendants will supervise and ensure that residents are following the rules governing safe practices throughout the park and tennis courts. They will have the authority to eject persons from the park who are not following park rules as set.

**RESERVATIONS FOR TENNIS and PICKLEBALL COURTS:** A reservation system will be implemented, the details of which will be provided at a later date.

**SINGLES PLAY:** 1 hour time court time limit

**DOUBLES PLAY:** 1 ½ hour court time limit

**LESSONS:** Private lessons are provided by the Head Pro/Director of Tennis, Xavier Cedeno and are restricted to residents, **who have paid the required daily admission or have obtained a seasonal membership**. He can be reached at (516) 982-9331.
